1. The parents of every child should attend as many monthly meetings as possible.
2. Parents should be aware of all projects children sign up for before they sign up. It will be the parents responsibility to see that their child is at every project meeting.
3. All project fees are to be paid to the leader before purchase of material is made.
4. Any child who misses three (3) consecutive monthly meetings without an explanation to the Key Leader will be expelled from the club.
5. Club dues of \$5.00 per member per year with a family cap of \$25.00 per year and must be paid by April meeting or members with unpaid dues will not be allowed to exhibit in Club Fair Booth.
6. All enrolled members are expected to participate in fund raising projects.
